




## **Bishopsgate Training Centre**

#### TRAVEL INFORMATION

## Visiting by car

From West End/West London: Follow the A214 through Wandsworth, Streatham, Crystal Palace and Elmer's End turning right at the junction with Monks Orchard Road. The hospital is located at the end of the road on the right hand side.

From Crystal Palace signs to West Wickham via A214 will guide you.

**From City/East London**: At the Elephant and Castle follow A215 to Herne Hill - left on to Croxted Road/South Croxted Road/Dulwich Wood Park to Crystal Palace Parade follow Anerley Hill (A214). Signs to West Wickham via A214 will guide you.

**M25** (from the East): Leave at Junction 4, follow A21 to junction with A232 (Chapter One Restaurant), follow A232 towards West Wickham. Turn right at junction with Monks Orchard Road.

**M25 (from the West):** Leave at junction 8 (A23) follow signs for central London. At Purley Cross turn right, sign posted A22 - turn left immediately and follow A2022 until West Wickham, turn left into Corkscrew Hill and left along West Wickham High Street.

## **Congestion Charge**

Bethlem Royal Hospital is not in the London congestion charge zone.





## **Parking**

There is substantial parking at Bethlem Royal Hospital. However the site does get busy at peak times; if possible please use public transport. There are several parking bays designated for the use of disabled drivers only. If you have difficulty finding a car parking space, please go to main reception.

## **Visiting by public transport**

By rail: The nearest stations are Eden Park (Zone 5) and West Wickham (Zone 5).

**From Eden Park station**, turn left along Links Way. At the junction with Monks Orchard Road/South Eden Park Road, walk down Monks Orchard Road. The hospital is on the right hand side at the end of the road. Alternatively take the 356 356 outside the station.

From Denmark Hill, the train takes approximately 20 mins to Shortlands Station. From Shortlands Station, take the 358 bus, by walking out of the station through the car park, turning left and walking up Shortlands Road to the bus stop (approximately 1 minute). Take the 358 bus to Langley Park School (10 minutes). The Langley Park School bus stop is adjacent to the roundabout at the bottom of Monks Orchard Road. Walk up Monks Orchard Road to the Bethlem Hospital site.

Bus Routes: 194, 356, 358, 119 (24 hrs), 494 and 198 service the Hospital.

**356** From outside the Bethlem Royal Hospital Gate takes you straight to Eden Park station; Elmers End; Anerley; Penge; Upper Lower Sydenham

119 West Wickham; Hayes; Bromley; Croydon; Croydon Airport

**198** Shrublands; Shirley; Croydon; Mayday Hospital; Thornton Heath

**194** Croydon; West Wickham; Elmers End; Beckenham; Penge; Sydenham; Forest Hill

**358** Crystal Palace; Anerley; Penge; Beckenham; Elmers End; Eden Park; Shortlands; Bromley

**Tram:** An interchange with London trams is provided at Elmers End Station, one stop by train from Eden Park.





## **Inter-Hospital Bus**

There is an inter-hospital bus that is primarily for patients, that travels between the Maudsley site and the Bethlem site. It is operated on a first-come, first-served basis and you may not get a space.

Staff need to be aware that the times of the buses are not scheduled according to the Trust training timetable. Anyone wishing to use this service will need to check that the timetable coincides with training times as it is your responsibility as a member of staff to arrive on time for training. Staff will need to use alternative transport if the timings are not compatible


## Inter hospital bus schedule

Departures from the Bethlem are at: 7.45 am, 9.30am, 11 am, 1 pm, 2.30 pm, 3.45 pm and 5.30 pm.

Departures from the Maudsley are at: 8.30 am, 10.15 am, 11.45 am, 1.45 pm, 3.10 pm, 4.45 pm and 6.05 pm.

## **Cycling**

The Trust has two secure cycle shelters on the Bethlem Hospital site: a 20 cycle compound in between the Chapel and Restaurant and a 10 cycle shelter opposite Chelsham House next to the River House car park. # **Bethlem Royal Hospital**

# By Train:

Nearest station is Eden Park (zone 5). From Charing Cross, Waterloo East, London Bridge or Cannon Street, take the Hayes train.

The hospital is about a mile from Eden Park station. Turn left on leaving the station and walk along Links Way and turn right at roundabout into Monks Orchard Road.

# By Bus:

Route 356 stops outside the hospital. Routes 194, 358, 119, 494 and 198 stop nearby.

# **Inter Hospital Bus:**

Runs between Bethlem and Maudsley Hospitals. Departs *from* Bethlem *to* Maudsley: 7.45 am, 9.30 am, 11 am, 1 pm, 2.30 pm, 3.45 pm, 5.30 pm. Departs *from* Maudsley *to* Bethlem Hospital: 8.30 am, 10.15 am, 11.45 am, 1.45 pm, 3.10 pm, 4.45 pm and 6.05 pm.

# By Car:

Parking is available on site. Please refer to your appointment letter or site map to locate car park nearest to the building you are visiting.
